The Jamshedpur Chapter has taken National Value Education Curriculum as the main objective.


In addition, the following immediate concerns of the Region will be addressed:

1. Stamp Paper of lower denomination not available, public having to pay 5 times to get their needed paper.
2. Safeguarding the residents against floods, by timely regulatory steps at dam sites in Jharkhand and adjacent State.
3. To stop letting factory effluence into Suvarnarekha.
4. To persuade an enlightened approach from the authorities to the Naxalite

unrest. The Naxal movement and such other ideologies should be met at the root mento-intellectual level.

FRNV INITIATIVES

National Value Restoration Council (NVRC) is to be set up as a Sovereign autonomous body, with equal number of Govt. and Civic Society members. NVRC will take up the task of imparting and instilling National Values by dialogues, institutionalized training, etc.. Ethical Surveillance Corps (ESC) will function as the eyes and ears of NVRC, consisting of

individuals, imbued with National fidelity and commitment.

National Value Education: FRNV will work towards the implementation of a National Value Education Curriculum that will impart the eternal values, by addressing all tiers of education throughout the country.

EVENTS

- A delegation from FRNV met the Central Vigilance Commissioner, Sri Pratyush Sinha and other Vigilance Commissioners, to discuss possible areas where FRNV could strengthen the arms of the government in addressing corruption.
- At a recent meeting held in the Capital on 13th March, project teams were identified to address actions in each of the following areas:
 1. National Value Restoration Council
 2. National Value Education Syllabus
 3. Police Reforms
 4. Electoral Reforms

Those present unanimously felt that, since the General Elections are round the corner, FRNV should expedite its activities in the area of Electoral Reforms.

FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES

The Constitution of India has clearly elucidated the fundamental duties. Part IV-A, Section 51A of our Constitution says:

- It shall be the duty of every citizen of India—
- a) to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;
 - b) to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom;
 - c) to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;
 - d) to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;

- e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;
- f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;
- g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers and wild life, and to have compassion for living creatures;
- h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- i) to safeguard public property and to abjure violence;
- j) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.
