

FRNV's New Strategy

A New Strategy for implementing the goals of Foundation for Restoration of National Values (FRNV) was decided at a review meeting held on 20th January 2018 at DMRC auditorium, New Delhi. The members of the management committee of FRNV - Dr E. Sreedharan, President; Sri Prem Arora, Treasurer; Sri Satish Kumar; Sri Ravi Malhotra and Sri Ashwani Kumar, Joint Secretary arrived at the venue much before the start of the programme.

The Registration started at 4.30 pm. FRNV Secretariat with Seema Pawar and Shilpi Garg helped in the registration process and other proceedings.

Many Friends of FRNV, CIRD Seeker, NGOs, railways and DMRC along with the DMRC Trainees attended the meeting.

Program started with a welcome note and introduction to the event by Sri Ashwani Kumar followed by screening of FRNV short Film to review the FRNV journey so far and also draw up future plan of actions.

Subsequently, Dr. E. Sreedharan addressed the gathering. He added a personal welcome to all the attendees and thanked everyone associated with FRNV. On this occasion, he reiterated about the vision and mission of the Foundation. Dr E. Sreedharan, President, FRNV, emphasized that "FRNV aim is to inspire society and instill values among all people, especially those at the decision making level", The mindset has to be changed so that people start rethinking about their lives in



terms of making their neighborhood, locality and the country a better place to live in.

He also explained in detail about the work FRNV has been doing since its inception and urged all the attendees to involve with FRNV by becoming its volunteers.



This was followed by a very interesting interactive session with the participants sharing their concerns & suggestions and following key projects have been identified along with volunteers for the working Groups:

- 1. National Value Based Education System
- 2. Ethics and Values orientation during Selection & Training of IAS
- 3. Improving the standard of education and keeping it concurrent
- 4. Sanitation and Hygiene at Bus Terminals, Railway Stations, Hospitals
- 5. Research Assistance for Electoral Reforms-Parliament Stalling, Politicians with convicted criminal record
- 6. Police Complaint Authority

Some of the points raised are as follows;

"Shri A K Prasad suggested that convicted politician on bail should not take part in public meeting and promote their party. President mentioned that it is already on FRNV agenda."



"Shri Mahendra Pratap Singhal, a Retd. Railway officer was very enthusiastic about FRNV cause and offered to volunteer 2 days every week for Value Based Education Task Force and also promised to give financial support."

"Smt. Indrani ji mentioned that RK Mission has adapted 3700 schools for providing Value Based Education. We discussed and agreed for knowledge sharing and collaboration for common objectives."

Shri Ashwani Kumar wrapped up the session with the Vote of Thanks.

The Review Meeting was concluded with the National Anthem.
